The Practice:

The practice at our college involves a range of initiatives and activities aimed at promoting environmental awareness and sustainability. Environmental Sustainability Initiatives and Practices at Our College:

1. Environmental Awareness Initiatives:

- Organizing awareness drives, brainstorming sessions, ecotrails, heritage walks, plastic collection and cleanliness drives, poster competitions, environment awareness rallies, photo exhibitions, tree plantations, conferences, seminars, workshops, plantation drives, and trekking expeditions.
- Making the campus litter-free, promoting conscious use of energy and water resources, and encouraging the use of renewable energy.

• Creating awareness about the importance of conservation and preservation of the environment.

2. Tree Plantation:

- Conducting an annual tree plantation drive both within the campus and its surrounding areas.
- Planting and maintaining around 150 saplings each year.
- Increasing the green cover in the locality and contributing to the conservation of the environment.
- Instilling a sense of responsibility towards the environment and promoting a sustainable way of life.

3. Rainwater Harvesting and Waste Management:

- Implementing measures to conserve water and manage waste effectively.
- Utilizing rainwater optimally through rainwater harvesting.
- Using drip irrigation and leakage-free pipelines and faucets.
- Adopting the 4R policy of Reduce, Recover, Recycle, and Reuse for waste management.
- Following a strict "No Plastic" policy for all stakeholders and promoting the use of eco-friendly alternatives.
- Providing separate color-coded bins for biodegradable and nonbiodegradable waste, which are then collected and managed appropriately.

4. Energy Audit and Sustainable Transportation:

- Using energy-saving devices such as timers, motion sensors, and programmable thermostats to reduce energy consumption.
- Promoting sustainable transportation by encouraging carpooling, cycling, and the use of public transportation.
- Installing charging stations for electric vehicles to promote the use of eco-friendly vehicles.

5. Waste Water Management:

• Installing an effluent water treatment plant to treat and reuse

- waste water for watering plants on campus, thereby conserving water resources.
- Recovering organic solvents through the use of rotary evaporators and reusing them, reducing the amount of waste generated and promoting a circular economy.

6. Cleanliness Drives:

- Regularly participating in campus cleaning drives.
- Collecting 'Nirmalya' from Peth-Vadgaon near the college and processing it into organic manure during the auspicious occasion of Ganesh Chaturthi festival, as part of their ongoing efforts to promote sustainable waste management.

7. E-waste Management:

- Digitizing measures to reduce paper usage and promote a paperless work environment.
- Collecting e-waste and plastic waste and handing it over to a specialized agency for proper disposal.
- Minimizing electricity usage and maintaining a green campus, fulfilling the institution's social commitment and creating environmental awareness among all stakeholders.

Evidence of Success:

The activities conducted under this best practice have helped to foster a culture of environmental awareness and sustainability among the college community and beyond. The various initiatives such as tree plantation drives, energy and environmental audits, waste management policies, water conservation efforts, and digitization of administrative processes have all played a significant role in creating a green campus and promoting sustainability practices.


